Well done to Harvey in Year 8 who has finished his stained glass window masterpiece! Harvey chose a brightly coloured fish swimming in the sea.

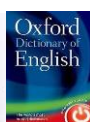
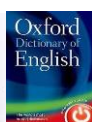
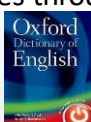
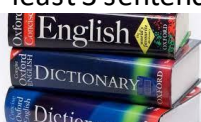
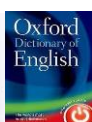
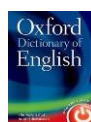
